## New Business: Ordinance 22-05: Chapter 9 Ethics

• An Ordinance was introduced at the October 2022 Town Council Meeting amending Chapter 9., Ethics in the Town Code. These changes were mandated during the General Session in 2022. All municipalities must adopt the changes to their Ethics Code for compliance with State law. Mrs. Ruff reviewed a copy of the Ordinance and explained that it was sent to the State Ethics Commission for review. The State Ethics Commission is scheduled to meet on the 17<sup>th</sup> of November to review updated Ordinances for compliance. The North Beach Ethics Commission will need to reconvene to certify its compliance. All Commission members will sign the compliance document.
